Causes

A fever can be caused by many clinical conditions from non-serious to serious life threatening this include the infections like viral, bacterial, parasites urinary tract infection, meningitis, malaria, appendicitis, other noninfectious causes also include vascculitis DVT, side effects of medications in body temperature over temperature set point due to either too much heat production or not enough heat loss.

If you've ever been sick, you've probably experienced having a fever, and you know how hard it can be to determine the underlying cause. Acute febrile illness can occur whenever the body is invaded by some type of infectious disease, but it is especially worrisome in tropical and sub-tropical regions where serious diseases loom.

These can include malaria, dengue, typhoid, chikungunya, Leptospirosis, scrub typhus, influenza, encephalitis, histoplasmosis, enteric fever, rickettsiosis, Hantavirus, and many, many others. Specifically, the hypothalamus is the part of the brain responsible for regulating body temperature, and it may decide to elevate body temperature in response to an infection.

Sign and Symptoms

In addition to causing elevated body temperature AFI can be accompanied by headache dizziness sweats chills muscles pain joint pain and weakness. Sometimes it also affiliated with respiratory symptoms like coughing or wheezing. A fever in itself is not fatale however it becomes problematic when the body temperature gets too high or last for an extended amount of time.

The overlapping feature of AFI with other vector-borne illnesses does pose a challenge for physicians to distinguish the symptoms from that of a common cold, viral fever or malarial infection. Specific traits that doctors associate with acute febrile illnesses comprise the following:

A high fever that lasts for more than 4 days and does not subside with the usual dose of antibiotics or antivirals, with body temperatures constantly being above normal Rashes on skin

Jaundice

Myalgia

Management of acute febrile conditions

Adequate fluid intake such as oral rehydration solution (ORS), water, fruit juice, coconut water and other fluids containing electrolytes and sugar.

Patients who are intolerable to oral fluids need intravenous fluid therapy; patients are advised to take bed rest and normal regular diet. In case of high fever, continuous cold sponging is advised, till temperature lower.

The patients having high temperature should be admitted and kept under observation. The patient is kept out of drafts and the room temperature is adjusted. If high temperature is not controlled then the patient should be referred to advanced medical center.

Homoeopathic therapeutics

Gelsemium: This natural homeopathic remedy is very beneficial for fever where the patients suffer from dizziness, weakness, and a tendency to faint. This condition is marked by an absence of thirst.

Rhus Tox: This homeoapthic remedy is considered to be the first choice in people who have fever along with extreme restlessness and body aches. A person experiencing this type of fever might want to remain in motion throughout in order to avoid restlessness. This remedy is also given for fevers as a result of getting wet in the rain:

Arsenicum album

A person who needs this remedy during flu feels chilly and exhausted, along with an anxious restlessness. The person may be thirsty, but often only takes small sips. If the digestive system is involved, nausea with burning pain, or vomiting and acrid diarrhea may occur. If the flu is respiratory, a watery,

runny nose with sneezing paroxysms and a dry or wheezing cough are often seen. The person's head usually feels hot, while the rest of the body is chilly.

Belladonna

This remedy relieves high fever of sudden onset with profuse sweating, and hypersensitivity to light and noise.

Eupatorium perfoliatum

This remedy relieves bone pains and body aches associated with flu and severe colds.

Ferrum phosphoricum

This relieves low-grade fever with weakness and tendency to nosebleeds and earaches.
